Margarita Cup Handicap Adjustments Formula: (daily adjustments based on the rating of each course, by tees played (round down from 0.4 / rounded up from 0.5) in all cases.

If age & Jack-cap = 85 play up a tee option or age 65 (rating difference adjusted to score).

Net Scores: 72-79 (No change Handicap), 69-71 (-1) (66-68 (-3) / 64-65 (-5), 62-63 (-7), 61 or lower (-9).

Net Scores: 80-83 (+1), 84-89 (+2), 90+ (+4)

Margarita Cup Individual Championship / 72 holes (full adjusted Margarita Cup handicap)
Stableford Net Quota Points (as shots fall on the card): Double Eagle 5 points, Eagle 4 points, Birdie 3 points, Par 2 points, Bogie 1 Point, Double Bogie 0 points

The Margarita Cup turns 19 in 2025 at a TBD destination and plans have already begun for Jackarita 20 – November 2026 of 5 rounds in Portugal!

Games Outline for The Jackarita Cup 18 Total Purse \$1000 (based on 12 players)

Opening Day: Days 1 – 3, 54 holes / Skins Game Lottery / Prize purse \$225

- 54-Hole high rollers Skins Game (Gross) – Every birdie gets you a ballot for the Pot of Gold. Extra ballot for additional eagles etc., – Pot of Gold winners: \$100 - 1st place, \$75 - 2nd and then two draws for \$30 & a \$20. of “all” remaining 10 players with or without a ballot.

Day One & Two: 36 Hole Hidden Partner Angus Glen Challenge / Prize purse \$240.

- Draw after round one for partners (Players set in 2 divisions by handicap with a team made up of one player from each). Total combined quota points on day one added to day two for 36 holes. *1st place \$100/team, 2nd place \$80/team and 3rd place team \$60/team.

Day Three: Moving Day Tree Partner 36-hole quota points (\$210)

- Players into tree divisions and teams made up of one player from each. If same handicap (age goes to higher flight. Tree partners in a group using a best quota points of the turd round: One player best front 9 quota, one player best back 9 quota and one player best 18-hole quota all on day Tree – all players must count. 1st place \$50ea., 2nd place \$20ea. Sorry, no Turd place.

Day Four: Final Round at The Jackarita Cup / Prize Purse \$325 + name on The Jackarita Cup

- Presentation of the Cup following play in clubhouse. Jackarita Cup Final: 72-hole Individual Stableford net quota total: Champion Wins name on the Cup + \$100, Silver \$75, Bronze \$50, 1st in stable-ford points in other two groups wins \$25 in each group. Low Gross after 72 Holes \$50

Rules of Play for all Events:

- 1) No out of bounds. All lost balls to be played at point of entry as lateral drop (add one stroke)
- 2) Maximum score/hole – pick up is Quad for handicaps 0-18, Quad+1 for handicaps 19+
- 3) Play as ball lies except Relief no nearer the hole from any casual water, holes, rocks, roots, paths, fire ants, etc. (1 club length no closer to the hole) / approved by another player. Mud balls may be clean and replaced.
- 4) Margarita Cup Formula will adjust handicaps after each round as per rules of the event
- 5) Tees set by committee. Options...85-factor (age plus Handicap) or if age over 65).
- 6) All ties for events will be broken by GAO retrogression rules (quota points), best final round, if still tied - best final round back 9, if still tied – final 6, final 3, final hole, then to prior day.
- 7) Keep a good pace, putts are good inside the bottom of grip to the bottom of the putter head
- 8) A rookie is not eligible to win the overall Margarita Cup as a player must have a minimum of 6 verified Margarita Cup scores in the vault for an official Margarita Cup Handicap.
- 9) JL is the official Referee & Scorer, failing him Jay, failing him Q, and failing him...Mick!
